(vs. 19)

Jesus' answer to  
John's disciples:  
(vs. 22ff)

Jesus and Isaiah  
Tell John what you  
Have heard  
Have seen

The blind: see!  
The lepers: cleansed!  
The lame: walk!  
The deaf: hear!  
The dead: raised!  
The poor: have Good News!

Don't stumble over the Messiah...  
in fact, you're blessed if you don't stumble!

What did you go out into the

Jesus' answer to the  
Multitudes  
(vs. 24ff)

Jesus and Malachi  
(A reed, man in soft clothes, a prophet?)  
Yes! A Prophet!  
(vs. 24-26)

Behold, My Messenger!  
He will prepare the way!  
(vs. 27)

No one...greater than John  
He was a testimony to God's justice  
...for those that were baptized by John  
(vs.28-30)

Preguntas numero tres:  
Jesus' answer to his culture

To what then shall I compare the men  
of this generation,  
and  
what are they like?  
(vs. 31)

Jesus and his generation  
(vs. 32-35)

They are compared to:  
Children playing and singing  
Critical accusers of demonic position

You don't appreciate somberness, and  
You don't like joyfulness

Yet, wisdom is vindicated by  
her children.
